Student Succumbs to Injuries – Fundraisers Planned for Sunday

LA PALMA, Calif. – The Long Beach Memorial Medical Center has notified the City of La Palma that the 16-year old Cypress resident and John F. Kennedy High School student who was critically injured in a traffic collision on November 1, passed away early this morning at about 12:40 a.m.

The traffic collision had occurred on November 1, at 6:45 a.m., as the student was crossing Crescent Avenue in a marked crosswalk at the intersection of Watson Street. The collision investigation is ongoing and additional witnesses are encouraged to contact the La Palma Police Department at (714) 690-3370.
